LEGISLATIVE LORE AND LINGO

Sayings and Doings of the Solons at the State Capital

Five Thousand Dollars Appropriated for an Exhibit at the Buffalo Exposition

Tallahassee, April 19.—The house today devoted the greater portion of its time to a discussion of the senate bill making incurable insanity good and sufficient grounds for divorce.

The bill was finally passed, after a hard fought battle, and will become a law upon the signature of the governor.

Among other bills passed by the house today was an act prescribing the jurisdiction of county judges' courts, and to provide for justices of the peace issuing warrants thereto.

Wolfe, of Escambia, introduced a bill regulating the holding of primary elections, as recommended in the last state democratic platform. The bill was drawn up by a committee appointed for the purpose.

Money for Exhibit

An important bill, and one which is generally favored, was introduced by Mr. Williamson of Hillsborough. It appropriates \$5000 for a state exhibit at the Pan-American Exposition.

Aside from the passage of memorials and the introduction of several new bills, of minor importance, nothing was done in the senate today.

Mrs. Maurice Strauss, of Ocala, spent a couple of days with her husband in the city last week. She was also the guest of Mrs. W. H. Stephens.

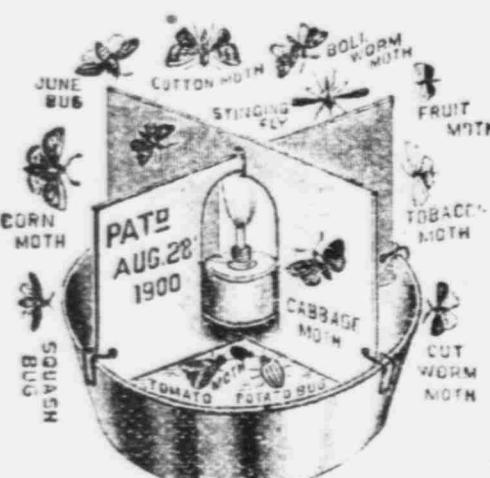
Born—Unto your editor and Lon Leitner eight kittens. The mothers are all doing well on canary birds brought in by their respective companions, Thomas Cat.

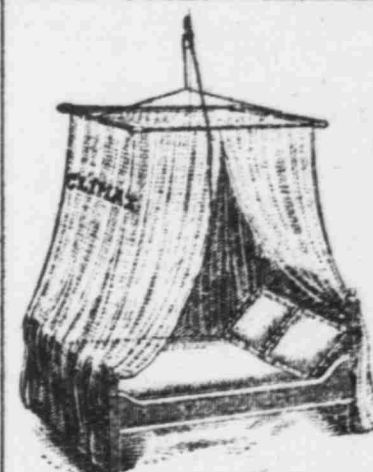
