THE FUEL OF THE FUTURE.

The Nantical Gazette makes the following sunconnecement in regard to the use of petro leum as fuel : We shall soon be able to announce a wonderful stride in the mechanical spplisness for using liquid fuel for generating steam in both marine and land boilers. The matter is in the hands of practical men, who will soon demonstrate that they can make from 28 to 30 gallons of crude petroleum, cost from 85 to 90 cents, do the work of a ton of coal, costing from \$4 to \$4.25, and without dirt or smoke, and when, as in the case of a large S'eamer carrying from forty to forty-five men in the fire-room, one man in each will be abundantly able to keep up a uniform pressure of steam at all times. Liquid fuel is the intervening step between coal and electricity, which will in due season turnish motion for the world. But until we arrive at a thorough knowledge of this subject and of motive power liquid fuel will have had its day and generation, wiping out the last remnant of barbarism coal. The fireman of the future can wear broadcloth in the fire-room, while the coal-passer will have laid down his TEXAS CATTLE TRADE, "shovel and hoe" to become memories of the past. This condition of things is near at hand.
