The fighting Josephs will meet before the Pacific Athletic club in the Vernon arena, on the afternoon of Labor day, September 24, with the official referee, Charles F. Eytan, acting as judge.

It does not take a great stretch of the imagination to see in the winner the next lightweight champion of the world. When it comes right down to a question of making the lightweight limit, 125 pounds ringside, Rivers and Mandot are the two boys from whom Al Wolgast has most to fear.

Rivers fought himself into one engagement with the present champion and the unsatisfactory result of this affair has left the coast public clamoring for another meeting between the pair. Should the Mexican defeat Mandot he must eventually find himself in the ring with the champion again.

Mandot has been "coming" for the past year. He has been boxing in sensational form and is the idol of the sporting fraternity south of the Mason and Dixon line. A clean-cut victory over Rivers would make of Mandot one of the best lightweight cards in the country, one that Wolgast could not afford to overlook.

With Al in his present poor form either Rivers or Mandot would have between the pair. Should the Mexican defeat Mandot he must eventually find himself in the ring with the champion again.

NEW YORK PLACES SIX THOUSAND SEE BIG CROWD GREET BAN ON CHAMPION JACK JOHNSON RACING CARD AT LAMAR FAIR

State Boxing Commission Refuses to Permit Him to Meet Jeannette in Scheduled Ten-Round Battle.

 New York, Aug. 22.—The Jack Johnson-Jo Jeannette boxing match, set for September 23th, at the St. Nicholas Athletic club, was declared off this afternoon, "for the betterment of the sport," by Jesse and Edward McManis, the promoters of the bout. The McManis brothers called off the match after a long conference behind closed doors with the state athletic commission.

Commissioners O'Neil and Dixon denied that any coercion was brought to bear by them to induce the McManis to declare off the proposed bout. "The commission decided long ago," said O'Neil, "that Jack Johnson would not be permitted to fight here. We believe now as we did then, that the presence of Johnson in a ring contest in this state would be detrimental to the best interests of boxing, the status of which has greatly improved under the Frawley law."

JOHNSON DECLARES HE WILL NEVER FIGHT AGAIN.
 Chicago, Aug. 22.—"That does not worry me," said Jack Johnson to-night when informed that his contest with Jeannette had been called off. "That means that I won't fight again. I simply wanted to fight Jeannette to show certain people that I wasn't all in as they claimed."

M'LOUGHLIN PICKED TO BEAT FIELD IN THE TENNIS TOURNAMENT.
 Newport, R. I., Aug. 22.—Eight aspirants for the national tennis championship in singles were left in the running when the fifth round of all comers tournament was finished today. Four were from New York, three from Philadelphia and one from San Francisco.

Four were made tonight at 5 to 2 that Maurice E. McLaughlin, the Pacific coast representative, would win the championship against the field. McLaughlin tomorrow will meet R. N. Williams, of Philadelphia, the clay court title holder.

MITCHELL AT HIS TRAINING CAMP

El Paso Middleweight Starts Preliminary Work for His Coming Bout with Jack Carson September 2.

Jack Mitchell is as popular as ever with Albuquerque fans. This was demonstrated last night by the crowd which thronged the training quarters of the El Paso middleweight on the occasion of his first workout for his coming battle on Labor day with Jack Carson, the undefeated Denver middleweight and champion of the Rocky Mountain states.

Mitchell did road work yesterday morning and finished up a day of active training and light gymnasium work at the New Mexico A. C. gym at the rear of the Sturges hotel. While he confined himself only to light exercises, the El Pasoan showed himself to be in fine physical shape and the next ten days should see him round into the best condition of his career. He probably will start boxing this evening and continue this each evening until the day before the fight.

Carson is due to arrive Sunday or Monday and he will do light training at the Elks theater, where a temporary gymnasium has been fitted up by Director Mark Levy, of the New Mexico Athletic club. Carson's arrival is eagerly awaited, as he has a great record and the fans are anxious to see just what he looks like. According to the dope, Carson has never been defeated. He won three annual amateur championships in Denver in succession, fighting as many as two or three battles a night during the week of the tournament. Having cleaned up all the amateurs, Carson entered the ranks of the professionals and so far has escaped being defeated. According to Jimmy Gardner, the Lowell, Mass. middleweight, Carson is a corner and is destined some day to be the peer of all boxers in his class. His most effective punch is a left hand jab. In fact, he is what is called a left hand fighter.

By the first of the week it is expected that the boys who are to appear in the semi-final and in the other preliminaries, will have been selected so they can get down to training.
