

1By Morning Journal Special Leased Wire.1 Oyster Bay, Oct. 25 .- On account of a number of threatening letters received by Colonel Roosevelt and the presence in Oyster Bay of a stranger, ern, S Edith and N. Walter. who attempted today to make his way into the colonel's house, steps were taken tonight to guard the life of the SI Down ex-president.

Colonel Roosevell's condition continued to improve today and his physician said he would be able to speak at the Madison Square Garden-meeting in New York City on Wednesday night, but he would be unable to do any further campaigning.

The man who attempted to see Colonel Roosevelt arrived in Oyster Hay this afternoon and set out on foot for Sagamore Hill. He was met at the door by the colonel's secretary. He was a tail, well dressed man. with a flowing black moustache and sombrero, which gave him the appearance of a westerner. He would give no reason for asking to see the colonel, but persisted until his de-mends were cut off sharply and he was told to leave Sagamore Hill. The stranger returned to the village, wrote a long nambling letter to Colonel Roosevelt and then disap-

The attempt on Colonel Roosevelt's life was said by Dr. George W. Fal-ler, of Oyster Bay, one of the colophysicians, to have stirred up "cranks," and to be responsible for the letters which Colonel Roosevell has received since his return to Oyster Bay. JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6. PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF SECTION FIVE (5) ARTICLE TWENTY-ONE (XXI) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO, H. Sob. S. J. R. 5., Filed May 29, 1912.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of

the State of New Mexico:

That Section Five (5) of Article four firsts, one second, at state fair, of the State of New Mexico, to-witz Twenty-one (21) of the Constitution "This state shall never enact any law restricting or abridging the right of suffrage on account of race, color or previous condition of servitude; and in compliance with the require " hereby provided that stillity: to end, write, speak and understand the English Language sufficiently well to onduct the outles of the office withor the ald of an interpreter, shall be necessary qualification for all state

> officers and members of the state legso that the same shall read as felman, termit;

ARTICLE NXL

Sec. 5. This state shall never enact any law restricting or abridging the right of suffrage on account of race. or or previous condition of servitude.
