STOCK MARKET SHOWS DECIDEDLY BETTER STRENGTH

Settlement of Controversy With Germany and Improved Wheat Crop Report Are Chiefly Responsible for Gain

Contrary to generally accepted predictions, the government report indicated that a material improvement of the condition of winter wheat had taken place during April. It was in this respect that forecasts of the report were decidedly in error. Ideal weather for planting had a beneficial effect on corn.

Provisions noted for the most part in harmony with the course of grain. Lower prices on hogs appeared to cut but little figure.
