A FEAT IN PHOTOGRAPHY.

Be-tween the shaly nature of the cliff, the slippery terraces covered with loose and stones and the detestable prickly pears I never had a more unpleasant or arduous task on a cliff be-fore. But I have lived to endure worse experiences, although not so painfully protracted as were these.

My very curt entry in my diary sum-marizes the whole job thus: "Bad shale ciliffs, vertical and daugerous. Height over sea, 160 feet. Top of cliff, 310 feet. The worst bit of rope work I ever did."
