

Our dispatches this morning are of more than usual interest. The fighting in Tennessee is uniformly favorable to our troops, but little doubt but that Savannah must fall, if it has not already done so.

Recruiting. In anticipation of another draft, nearly all the cities of the State are engaged in procuring recruits, that the demand upon them may be filled in advance. In most cases large bonuses are being paid, and good recruits are obtained, as a consequence.

Affairs are still unchanged at Nashville. Both armies are building works, and, as yet, neither seems inclined to attack. The Federal lines stretch in a semi-circle around the city, the wings resting on the Cumberland, above and below, with a distance of six miles between the two points of contact with the river. The rebel army stretches in front of, and parallel with ours, at a distance of eight hundred yards, but without touching the river on either flank. The fact that Hood has not already attacked Nashville seems conclusive against the probability of his attacking it at all. Even if he could break through our present line two miles south of the city, he would have to march across a low, level plain, and force the passage of the Cumberland, in the face of a fire from the elevated position on which Nashville stands. Desperate and rash as he is, he will not dare attempt such a movement as this. He may have designed crossing the Cumberland above Nashville and advancing into Kentucky, forcing Thomas to follow with the whole, or the larger part of his army, or his object may be to keep the garrison at Chattanooga in its present location until the failure of its supplies shall force it to evacuate the place and retire to Knoxville. The problem is one of much interest and importance. Hood's army is badly clad and provisioned for a movement in any direction, during the present cold weather. His delay in front of Nashville, has enabled Thomas to concentrate any army superior to his own in every respect, and just as soon as the weather will admit of a movement, the hero of Chancellorsville will force Hood to battle, with all the advantages against the rebel General. A few days more will doubtless determine the prospects of the campaign in some way. At present the advantages are clearly on the Federal side.

Let us especially entreat the clergy of the various denominations to address themselves systematically to this great work of religious and patriotic duty, and by thorough visitation and inquiry, make themselves acquainted with every case of need in the neighborhood in which they live, and then make earnest appeals to their congregations to supply the want which they have discovered. In this way I am assured that they can accomplish more than any other class of men. And again, let me appeal to the various county and city authorities throughout the State, to make ample appropriations for the relief of soldiers families in their respective jurisdictions. Some it is true, have made liberal provisions, others have done nothing, and others again have taken action which comes far short of meeting actual necessities. Every consideration of patriotic duty, humanity, Christian obligation, and the honor of our people, implore it alike upon our authorities and our citizens that our soldiers' families shall be permitted to wait for the necessities and comforts of life in a State overflowing with prosperity and abundance.
