Then Driven Out of Weirton, W. Va.

by Police and Deputies. Weirton, W. Va., Oct. 8 .- One hunired and eighteen alleged members of the Industrial Workers of the World, captured in a raid near here yesterday, were marched into the pubtic square of Weirton, forced to kiss the American flag and were then hriven out of town by police and deoutles. Seven others, suspected of being the leaders, after kissing the flag, were taken to the county jail at New Comberland, where they will be held pending investigation by Fedral authorities.

The raid was carried out without ny serious disorder. Authorities of Hancock county and Wierton had been searched for the rendezvous of he alleged I. W. W. since several eys ago, when there appeared on the dewalks here written threats that the I. W. W. will get you.' Monday ight the meeting place of the men wanted was located m an old barn on he Hancock county road, south of nere. It was surrounded by heavily rened deputies, and a few entered the parn. The few men in the barn sought o escape without success.

A search of the place resulted in he finding of a large quantity of 'red" literature-ball a ton, it was icid-in which the flag of anarchy was extolled and the prediction made but the extremists would rule the verld. The deputies also found the nombers of the organization, meeting n the barn. Immediately deputies were sent out, and the men were ounded up in the public square. There was one fight after another
