

MISSING BALLOON IN LAKE

Wreckage of Wichita Found, But Two Occupants Are Lost

St. Louis, Oct. 11.—The wreckage of the balloon "Wichita," in which Capt. Carl W. Hammann and Lieutenant J. W. Heyden, Jr., St. Louis, were on, was found in the nation's championship balloon race October 4, according to a telegram received by officials of the race here yesterday.

No trace of the two balloonists was found, the message amplified.

REBELS SEIZE TOWN

Rome, Oct. 11.—Reports from Italy state that the town of Rieti, the sulphur mining district, has been seized by rebellious peasants. Four thousand of the peasants engaged in an attempt to take possession of land, clashed with troops sent against them, seven persons being killed and many others wounded.

The troops and the town authorities, it is added, were compelled to retire, leaving Rieti in the possession of the rebels.

KING MAY ABDICATE

Victor Emmanuel Said to Have Expressed Intention if Sedition Continues

London, Oct. 11.—It is learned from a high diplomatic source that Annunzio's raid on Fiume has led to a serious internal situation in Italy. The government finds itself defied by the majority of the army.

King Victor Emmanuel, it is said, has intimated his intention to abdicate if the sedition continues to spread.

Rumors of the assassination of the poet D'Annunzio have not been confirmed.



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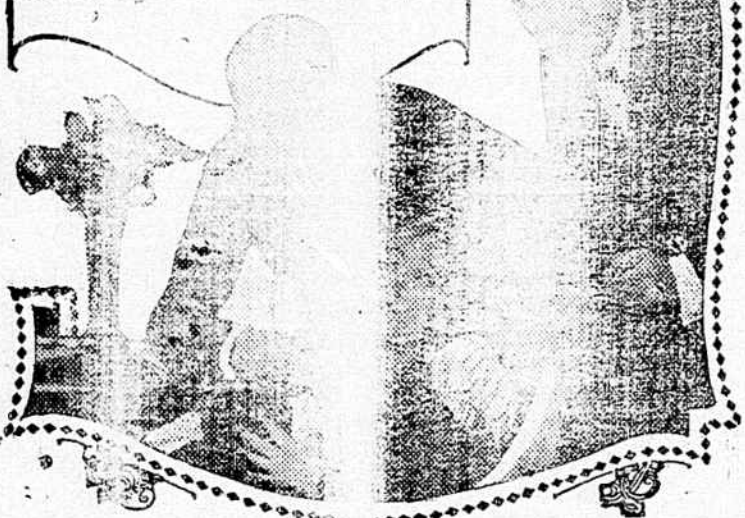
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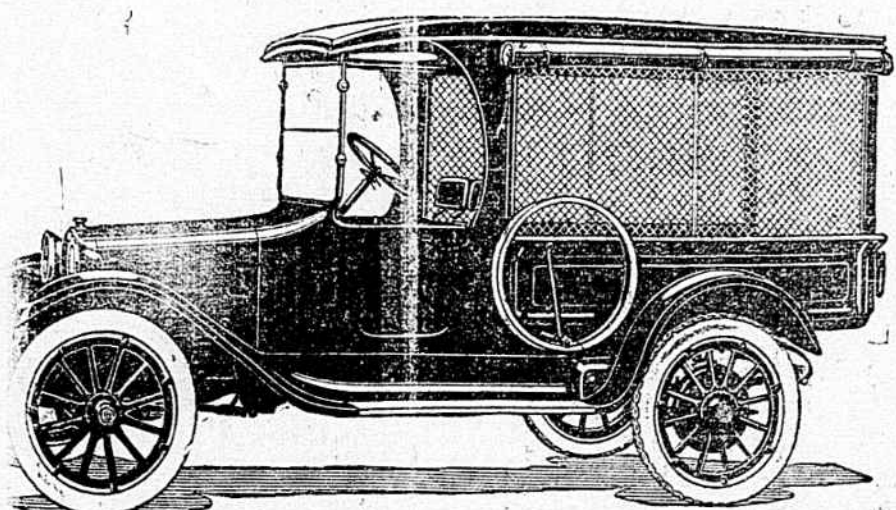
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
