

**HAASE LOSES HIS LEG**

**Amputation Due to Assassins' Attempt on German Leader's Life**  
 Berlin, Oct. 28.—Hugo Haase's right leg was amputated today above the knee. The operation was necessitated by the condition of the bone, which had been smashed by a bullet.

Haase, who is the leader of the Independent Socialist party of Germany, was shot and wounded entering the Reichstag on October 8. Several operations have been performed and Herr Haase's condition is considered serious.

**THREATEN STRIKE**

**In Chicago 12,000 Trainmen Vote to Quit Thursday Unless Demands Are Met**

Chicago, Oct. 28.—Fourteen lodges of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, representing 12,000 men in the Chicago switching district, voted at a secret meeting Sunday to strike Thursday unless their wage demands are met in full. A vote on the proposition is in progress in the other lodges of the 100,000 members throughout the country.

**PREPARES FOR CLASH**

Santiago, Chile, Oct. 28.—The Chilean cruiser, Esmeralda sailed northward Sunday and other units of the Chilean fleet are being prepared for sea duty. It is rumored they will follow the Esmeralda. This step on the part of Chile follows insistent reports of a probable revolution in Peru and information that the Peruvian government is making military preparations in the southern

part of that country for the alleged purpose of diverting popular attention from the revolt which is said to be impending.

Officials of the Chilean government who were interviewed Sunday night did not wish to commit themselves as to the sailing of the Esmeralda further than to say that the measure was one made against possible events. Information received from an authori-

tative source, however, is to the effect that the government, while it does not expect a conflict, sent the Esmeralda northward in advance of the Chilean fleet to show that this country was prepared to maintain order on the northern frontier and would not permit revolutionary movements in any way to touch Chilean territory or to involve Chilean citizens or authorities.
