## DILLON MAKES ATTACK ON FOOD AUTOCRACY

New York, Sept. 7.—Senator Elton R. Brown, majority leader in the state senate, is accused by John J. Dillon, state commissioner of foods and markets, with having defeated the effort to give the people of this city cheaper milk.

Commissioner Dillon made his accusation in the Hotel McAlpin, where he spoke at the luncheon of the Rotary club. He said the Towner bill would have enabled him to try out a plan by which he would guarantee to deliver milk to New York city consumers at from 2 to 3 cents a quart lower than current prices.

"When that bill was in committee," said Mr. Dillon, "Senator Brown was there and would not let the bill come out of committee. If he had there were enough men in the senate to pass it."

Scoring the food speculator, whom he likened to a pig with its nose in the trough, Commissioner Dillon said: "If we are going to fight hypocrisy tyranny and autocracy, just let's get down to business here and start in to fight the conscienceless food speculating autocrat. If you take the food speculators' profit away from them they are going to fight."

Referring to the recent appeal of President Wilson to the nation to produce more, Mr. Dillon said that food had been wasted all over the country.

State should sell the products in open markets and not to food speculators.
