## CONTINUE MANSLAUGHTER

The case of Perth Amboy, N. J., was not closed up until after the outcome of an accident, when Gardner ran into and killed twelve year old Eva Bud-sack in Perth Amboy on June 4, with his motorcycle. Assistant Prosecutor Coan is representing the state, and Charles T. Cowenhoven the defendant. Gardner was running his motorcycle along Amboy avenue in that city at 6 o'clock at night, and ran into the child, as she and her brother were running a small express wagon along the road. She was so badly injured that she died the next day.

The state attempted to claim that the man was riding along recklessly, while the defense claimed that the accident was unavoidable. Gardner, who lives in Bruck avenue, in Perth Amboy, was not indicted when his case was first presented to the grand jury, and he was recently rearrested when the grand jury reconsidered the case, and indicted him.

## LOCAL ROYAL ARCANUM ON VISIT IN SPOTSWOOD
