



Common salt is a valuable man ere for most crops, and has been used from ancient times. An inexpensive but durable method of painting old buildings is as follows: First give them a coat of crude petroleum, which is the oil as it comes from the wells, and can be procured for about \$4 to \$5 a harrel n almost any town or city. Then mix one pound of "metallic paint," which is brown or red hematite iron ore finely ground, to one quart of linseed oil, and apply this over the petroleum coat. The petroleum sinks into the wood and makes good ground-work for the iron and oil paint. The color of the iron The World Famed paint is a dark reddish brown, and is not at all disagreeable; it is a color not readily soiled, very durable, and is fire proof.

Nearly all dairymen now think milk is injured by being cooled too suddently-by ice or patent appliances. Also that warm milk should not be mixed with cold, as by pouring milk into a can that contains nilk already cooled.

Old cows, old oxen, old sows and, old hens, form the bulk of the stock upon many farms. The young animals are sold off This is the reverse of what is wise and profitable.

Reducing Bones for Gardens,

It is not often that bones can be ollected on the farm in sufficient quantities for field crops, but every little excellent manure by saving those within his reach. It is use. less to recommend converting them into home made super-phosphate by using sulphuric acid; the difficulty and trouble in producing the acid away from cities, and the care and experience required to use it, are sufficient objections. There are, however, two modes of reducing the bones which every gardener may easily adopt. One is to place them in thin layers in a fermenting heap of manure which, if they are prev lously broken, will soften them enough to cause crumbling after the apse of weeks, when the heap is worked over. Even a common hotbed will do, if the bones are first mode is to boil them as follows:

Mix them in a large kettle, with wood ashes, and to make the ashes caustic add about a peek. caustic add about a peck fresh lime to each barrel of bone Saturate and cover the ashes and with water, and then apply heat, say for twenty-four hours, or during the day for two consecutive days. All the bones by this time, except the very hardest parts, will be so reduced as to be easily pulverized, being in a pasty condition, suitable for lacing in layers in making the compost heap. Another day's boiling will reduce the remainder of the hard bones,-New York World,


