

FARM BOARD BUYING PLANS CHANGES BRING SWIFT UPRISE BREAKS

For First Time in Years March Wheat Sells for 98 3/4 Cents

Chicago, Feb. 25.—(AP)—Sudden changes in buying plans of the federal farm board cooperative grain organizations led to a sharp rise in grain prices today.

March delivery of wheat in the fall below \$1.00 for the first time in years, and sold as low as 98 3/4 cents.

Notable lessening of the severe selling pressure which has been so much in evidence in the wheat market since late last week became very apparent much of the time today.

A handpick of friends of higher prices here in early upturn in Liverpool quotation were lost at the finish.
