It seems to be generally understood that the Pauls Valley line will be built before the opening of the new country. The company is only waiting to complete the line now under construction from Anadarko to Fort Sill.

The final survey for the Pauls Valley extension has been made, leaving Chickasha just south of the old stock yards in the south part of the city. Property has already increased in value in that part of the city owing to the fact that the Rock Island people have reserved part of the ground near the stock yards for the erection of extensive repair shops.
