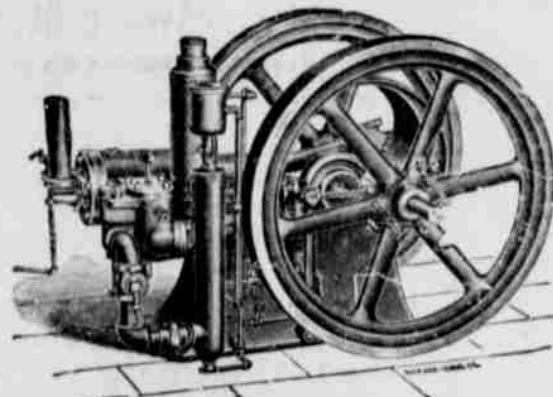

RACE WAR IS FEARED.

Whitecaps Threaten an Arkansas Negro and Bloodshed Follows.

A special from Camden, Ark., says:

News has reached here from Leake township, Nevada county, that a party of white men sent word to Lige Seigler, a negro, that they would attempt to whip him last night and received word that some of them would get killed if they came.

The party went out and the report is that Seigler and his son shot into them, killing Lewis Haynes, brother of State Senator Haynes, and Hop Halton, a brother of John Halton, a prominent merchant of Stephens.

There are some 400 negroes and thirty white people in this township and it is said that racial troubles have been brewing for some time. At last reports parties of white people had left for the scene of the trouble from Waldo and Stephens and the negro's house was still surrounded.
