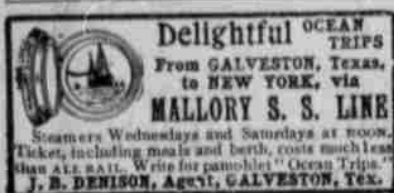

THE C. O. & T. RAILROAD.

A Survey is Now Being Made Over the Contemplated Route.

J. W. Howell, chief engineer of the Colorado, Oklahoma and Texas railroad, was in the city last night and was a guest of his brother-in-law, T. E. Roland. Mr. Howell talked quite freely to Mr. Roland about the new road, and said that it would be built without a doubt, as it was a Gould road and the Goulds always mean business.

From what we could learn a surveying party has recently started out from Duncan coming this way, and Mr. Howell is in advance of the party picking out the best practicable route.

The road, as being surveyed now, will not take in any towns between Duncan and Ardmore, but pass between Keller and Sneed, thereby taking in the oil belt west of Ardmore.

As the road approaches Ardmore it will pass through the John Seltzer place, west of the old asphalt mines, through the old Walker pasture. Striking the town it will pass through the Third ward, crossing the Santa Fe at the Ardmore nursery, below the oil mills and on out by the Ardmore coal mines, taking in Holder and Lebanon, then on to Denison.

Mr. Howell says that Duncan has raised her bonus and \$1,500 of the money has been paid over to the road.

The road at present will run from Lawton to Denison, a distance of about 135 miles.

Mr. Howell talked very enthusiastically of the road and feels sure of it being built, and that, too, as soon as it is possible to do so. The projectors, of course, are anxious to secure their right-of-way through the territory before the Indians allot the land.
