

GOOD ROADS ASSOCIATION

Was Organized at Guthrie Last Week.

Officers Elected.

The Good Roads Association of Indian Territory and Oklahoma has elected L. H. Morris, of Tulsa, president. It is the second of October, 1904, and the association has been organized and is now ready to do its work. The new association is composed of 100 members from all over the state.

Representatives of the association have been appointed to organize similar associations in the various counties of the state. The association is composed of men of good character and experience, and the officers are: President, L. H. Morris; Vice-President, W. C. Price; Secretary, G. W. McNauley; Treasurer, W. C. Price; and Auditor, W. F. Wilson. The association is now ready to begin its work.

The following officers were elected:

A. C. Price, Ardmore City president; W. H. Warren, Broken Bow president; A. W. McNauley, Choctaw county; W. C. Price, All other districts. President, L. H. Morris; Vice-President, W. C. Price; and Auditor, W. F. Wilson. The new organization is now ready to begin its work.

The first officers will soon have to be appointed to the territorial bill committee, and a committee of communication which shall consist of a meeting place each year. The meetings for the first year will be held in Muskogee. A committee composed of John Geddie, Senator; Col. Rhodes, Judge, Ardmore, and Charles M. Taylor, Mangum, will act in conjunction with the committee of the territorial board of agriculture to draw a good roads bill to be presented to the next session of the territorial legislature for passage. The bill will be ratified by the Farmers' Institutes in each county in Oklahoma and nation in Indian Territory. Each county and nation will also elect five delegates to attend the national good roads convention to be held in St. Louis on May 10 to 21.

Resolutions were adopted endorsing the working of short term penitentiary convicts and county prisoners on the roads in Oklahoma and Indian Territory, and resolutions were also adopted endorsing the county supervision of the working of roads.


