

**SHOENFELT WANTS REPORT.**

**SIMPLE REMEDY FOR CATARRH.**

Requests Nation Attorneys to Tell About Tribal Tax Decision.

A special from Muskogee says: The Indian agent has asked the attorneys of the Choctaw and Chickasaw nations for the exact status of the tribal cases and as soon as their reply is received and the Indian offices here have received official notice from the courts these matters will be laid before the department of the interior and it will be up to Mr. Hitchcock to say whether he will try to enforce the collection of the tribal tax. It is the general belief here, in official circles, that the secretary will make no order until after the court of appeals of the Eighth district has made a decision in the matter. The case in the Choctaw Nation will be appealed and the plaintiffs in the case have given a \$10,000 bond and the injunction will be observed until a decision has been rendered by the higher courts. This case is so similar to the one in the Creek Nation that it is not likely that the secretary would go up against the Creek Nation tax proposition before the courts pass up on the Choctaw case and run the risk of a lot of damage suits. In the Cherokee Nation the tribal taxes have already been repealed and it is believed that the Creek Nation will also repeal the law before the court of the Eighth district will have rendered a decision.
