POSTOFFICE RECEIPTS GROWING.

Significant Increase Over Farming Receipts.

A glimpse of the rapid growth of Ardmore may be seen from the receipts of the Ardmore postoffice.

The gross receipts of the first six months of 1905 amounted to \$8,708.29 as against \$6,915.12 for the same period in 1904, showing an increase in gross receipts of \$1,793.17.

During the first six months of 1905 there were registered here 1,509 letters. During the same period in 1904 there were registered only 1,211 letters.

In April, May and June the total expense of the office amounted to \$3,974.70. This amount paid the salaries of the postmaster, clerks, carriers, five railway postal clerks, house rent and all incidental expenses. After all these expenses had been met there was remitted to the postoffice department a net profit of \$509.12.
