

The next thing, when liquor is impossible to get, is to loaf up with cocaine, and it soon gets to

be a habit. The manufacturers and distributers of the "near beers" that were sold so extensively before and after statehood and are now outlawed are trying to manufacture a drink that will look and taste like beer but have no alcohol in it, although containing a sufficient amount of cocalne to get the "dopy" effect. They believe there would be a big sale of this especially among negroes and Indians:
