Senate Bill No. 215—A Bill. To be entitled an act to amend the act in the U. S. imports. It is hereby enacted by the Congress of the U. S. Section 1. That on and after the passage and approval of this act there shall be levied and collected upon all articles imported into the U. S. from foreign countries...

Schedule A—Cottons, oils and lard. Alcoholic perfumery or other such products, twenty per centum ad valorem. Alkalies and amoniacs, five per centum ad valorem. Alumina or the compounds of such, 14 of one cent per pound.

Schedule B—Metals and the manufactures of such. Iron ore or pig iron, eighty cents per ton. Cast iron, ten per centum ad valorem. Steel arms and iron washers, two cents per pound.

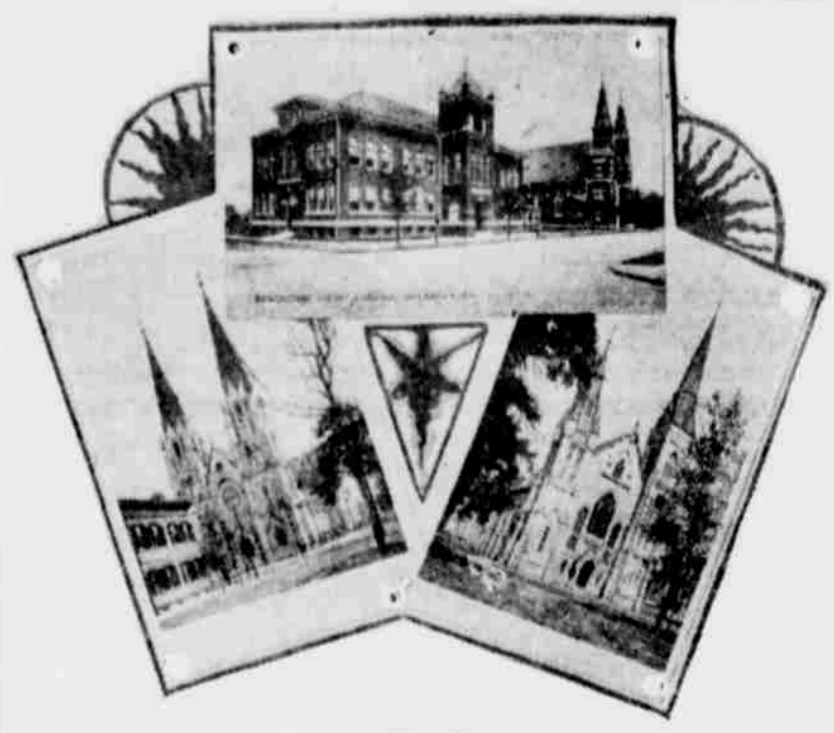
