Notice Water and Sewer Extension.

All citizens desiring extension of water mains and sewer mains under the recent bond issue, are hereby notified to file applications for such extensions or before the 20th day of November, 1909, with the Commissioner of Water, Lights and Sewer, at the City Hall. All applications must contain a detailed description of the location of the mains, with respect to streets, and the bona fide signatures of property owners along the proposed route, 25 per cent of such property owners (who must be designated in the petition) agreeing to make connections, with said mains when same shall be completed, and be subject to the payment for service, as provided by the Ordinances of the City of Armore. In case of failure of any of the designated persons embraced in the above agreement to make connection with either or both of said mains at the time of completion thereof, it is expressly understood that such persons bind themselves to pay to the City of Armore the minimum charge for each service petitioned for. For the period of one year from date of completion of each service, authorizing said City to collect for same as provided by Ordinance. Provided, however, that above agreements shall not apply in case of extension of water mains for fire protection.

RESOLUTION NO. 8.

A resolution declaring the necessity of improving portions of North Washington Street, C Street, North-west, Second Avenue, Northeast, A Street, Northeast, Broadway, Third Avenue, Northeast, First Avenue, Southwest, and Stanley Boulevard in the City of Armore, State of Oklahoma, by grading, paving, guttering, curbing and draining the same.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE CITY OF ARDMORE, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve the following streets and parts thereof in the City of Armore by grading, paving, guttering and draining the same, to-wit:

North Washington Street, beginning at the north line of 19th Avenue, Northeast, and extending to the north line of Tenth Avenue, Northwest.

C Street, Northwest, beginning at the south line of Broadway, and extending to the north line of Ninth Avenue, Northwest.

Second Avenue, Northeast, beginning at the east line of A Street, Northeast, and extending to the north line of Washington Street, Northeast.

A Street, Northeast, beginning at the north line of Broadway, and extending to the north line of 19th Avenue, Northeast.

Third Avenue, Northwest, beginning at the north line of Broadway, and extending to the north line of 19th Avenue, Northwest.

First Avenue, Southwest, beginning at the south line of Washington Street, Southwest, and extending to the west line of C Street, Southwest.

Stanley Boulevard, beginning at the west line of C Street, Southwest, and extending to the west line of C Street, Southwest.

Section 2. All the expense of said improvements, including the street intersections and crossings, shall be paid by special assessment to be assessed and levied against the lots and tracts of land benefited thereby as provided by an act of the legislature of the state of Oklahoma, approved April 17th, 1908, entitled "An Act to provide for the improvement of streets and other public places within cities of the first class by grading, paving, guttering, curbing and draining the same, and declaring an emergency."

Section 3. That this resolution shall be published in six consecutive issues of the Armore Morning Democrat and the Daily Ardmoreite, each being a daily newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Armore.

Section 4. An amendment is hereby declared by resolution subject to be necessary for the improvement of the public safety that this act take effect immediately upon its passage and approval and publication. Passed November 18th, 1909.
