

DRY ENFORCEMENT BILL SURE TO PASS

Test Vote Indicates Sentiment of Lower Branch for Immediate Consideration.

TO VOTE EARLY NEXT WEEK

Final Enactment May Be Deferred—Debate Is Sharp—Anti-Prohibitionists Make Hard Fight.

WASHINGTON, July 8.—The House in adopting 231 to 205 today a special rule for immediate consideration of prohibition enforcement legislation, indicated that it will vote on the measure within the 12 hours of general debate allowed members to speak for and against its passage.

But despite this big majority and the promise of a "chairman" without the time and committee might not be used, indications tonight were that a vote on the bill itself will not be reached this week.

It was understood that the House will take up the measure on Thursday, to resume being calendar day.

No attempt was made today to split the bill so as to take up the first part relating solely to enforcement of the prohibition law, with a view to its early passage.

It was expected that the measure will be done later, and while members fighting for modification or repeal of the wartime act were hopeful in the interim, they are announcing their determination to keep on fighting until the whole question of enforcement legislation was settled in the house.

Supported by Volstead. The principal speech in support of the Judiciary committee report was made by Chairman Volstead, who declared he did not belong to the anti-saloon league and had never made a prohibition address.

Mr. Volstead told the house that in his committee the measure could define intoxicating liquors as a beverage containing 1 1/2 per cent alcohol, while another congress might put quite a different restriction upon it.

He said that would come to the country with the elimination of liquor.

Days Respects to Carranza. MEXICO CITY, July 8.—Kania von Kania, who since February, 1934, has been Austrian minister at Mexico, today paid his respects to President Carranza and the Mexican foreign office before leaving for Havana.

He was expected that the Mexican government having announced that permanent diplomatic relations with the European situation becomes stable, Baron Fujiwara Otori, Japanese minister to Mexico, will leave this city tomorrow morning on the Mexican ambassador to the United States, who is going to Washington.

Adopt League Report. PARIS, July 8.—The committee of the chamber of deputies appointed to consider the peace treaty day adopted a report by Victor Adamier, former minister of marine, on the league of nations. The report favors amendment of the league covenant on the line with the amendment proposed by the French representative on the league of nations commission.

The committee decided to hear Premier Clemenceau on the conditions under which the treaty was prepared.

Swift Denies Charges. CHICAGO, July 8.—Louis F. Swift of Swift & Co. tonight issued a statement denying that his company employed any special transportation privileges from the federal rail administration, which was declared in a petition filed with the interstate commerce commission yesterday by the National Wholesale Grocers' association to have favored Chicago packers.

The association particularly charged that the packers shipped goods along with treats reaching their destination ahead of other freight.

Lindsey to Appeal. DENVER, Colo., July 8.—Judge Ben H. Lindsey today obtained permission from the state supreme court to appeal to the United States supreme court from the recent decision of the state supreme court sustaining a fine of \$100 against him on a contempt charge. Judge Lindsey was fined as the result of his refusal to disclose information given him by a ward in court in connection with a murder trial.
