Variegated Repertoire of Noted Baritone Pleases Critical Tulsa Audience.

The appearance of Emilio de Gogorza, the eminent baritone in concert hall on Tuesday evening under the auspices of the Robert R. Carson concert course, has been considered to be the banner event in a musical way for the season so far.

The Apollo club of Tulsa appeared at the same time.

Mr. de Gogorza sang a versatile and very beautiful program and with his rich resonant voice and ability to interpret gave a program quite unusual. He is a perfect linguist. After the first French group he sang an old English ballad, "When Dolls" as an encore. The Spanish group was a schizophony and to much applause, the singer gave the ever popular "La Paloma." In the rendition of this well known song, de Gogorza, it is said, excels, and he was compelled to respond with another number and gave "Claveles."

Mr. de Gogorza and the Tulsa club were greeted with a splendid audience. Among them was Paul Althouse, a Metropolitan tenor who, while passing through Tulsa Tuesday was the guest for the evening of Mr. and Mrs. Carson. Mr. Althouse took occasion to pay high tribute to the artist of the evening, saying he was

the most popular baritone on the American concert stage.

The Apollo club was given quite an ovation, and after their second group of songs, responded with a repetition of "The Pilot."

Try This Easy Method Recipe for CHOCOLATE CAKE

1 cup Yukon's Best Whole Wheat Flour
1 cup sugar
1/2 cup fat
2 eggs
1 teaspoon salt
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/4 teaspoon soda
1 tablespoon melted chocolate
Buttermilk
Sift together all dry ingredients. Cream the fat and the sugar. Add the eggs, whole and beat thoroughly. Add the melted chocolate, and some of the buttermilk. Alternate with the dry ingredients until all of the dry materials have been used, and the cake is of the "heavy pour batter" consistency. Bake in a well oiled sheet cake pan, in a moderate oven, until the top will not dent at the touch.
