IS SUCCEEDED BY MILLER

Congressman From Minnesota
to Act As Temporary
Chairman

CHICAGO, Jan. 4.—James B. Reynolds, secretary of the republican committee since 1912, has resigned, it was announced today, to take the management of the campaign of Gov. Calvin Coolidge. Reynolds, for the nomination for president. The resignation is effective January 10. The announcement from central western headquarters of the republican national committee said it was expected that Clarence B. Miller of Minnesota, for 10 years a member of congress from the Duluth district, would be made acting secretary. He would assume all of Mr. Reynolds' duties until the national committee takes formal action.
