We have more nut-of-town customers, and we have a larger mail order business than we have ever had before. I attribute this largely to advertising. The circulation of our newspapers, is one hig factor in the increase our mail order and out-of-town business, and advertising by word of nouth is another. It is surprising how many inquiries concerning merchandles, and resultant sales, we have as the result of something said about the store by year ple who were just passing through the oily.

Orders from Far Away. "As to the stope of our trade to ritory, it is difficult to define. Or railroad refunds show that the number railroad refunds show that the num-ber of people come in from near-by towns and make purchases is larger than ever before. On the other hand, we have mail orders from all parts of the country. We had an order the other day from Vancouver, and we have had orders from the sast, and from Florida."

Good roads, coupled with general improvement in the business satur-

improvement in the business situa-tion is the reason given by furni-ture men for the increase in their out-of-town trade.
"Our out-of-town business, I should say, has increased 75 per cent over what it has ever been before," said I. G. Rosser of the Rosser-Casebeer Equature company, "We have a larger number of out-of-town buyers than we have ever had. This is due largely to improved highways. Our trucks make deliveries of fur-

Our trucks make deliveries of furniture to purchasers living 40 and 50 miles from Tulas, something that was impossible until we had good roads in this territory."

C. A. Mayo of the Mayo Furniture company said that the general increase in the volume of husiness along all lines had been reflected in their own business, affecting very materially the out-of-town trade. The Mayo Furniture company does a much larger out-of-town business than it did a year ago, using trucks for delivery and going as far as Bartlesville and Oknuigee. Mayo predicted that the time is not far distant, with the constant improvement of highways, when furniture trucks will be making deliveries to points 100 miles distant.
