

PUBLIC ADVERTISING

An Ordinance declaring the intent of the Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles to change and establish the grade of Fickett street from a point 690 feet south of the south line of Fourth street to Sixth street.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Council of the City of Los Angeles to change and establish the grade of FICKETT STREET,

At a point on the east side 600 feet south of the south line of Fourth street the grade shall be 303.67, and 303.54 at a point on the west side opposite thereto.

Elevations refer to the top of the curb, are in feet, and are above a plane which is 255 feet below City datum plane.

Sec. 2. That the exterior boundary of the district which is hereby declared to be benefited by said change of grade and to be assessed to pay the benefits, damages and costs thereof are hereby described as follows:

Beginning at the most southerly corner of lot "2" block "1" of Subdivision Lots 1 and "2" of J. W. Strong's Tract as per map recorded in Book 24, page 53, Miscellaneous Records of the

the northernly line of Sixth street to a point distant 150 feet westerly of the westerly line of Fickett street; thence northerly and parallel with the westerly line of Fickett street to a point distant 600 feet southerly of the southerly line of Fourth street; thence easterly and parallel with the southerly line of Fourth street to a point distant

150 feet easterly of the easterly line of Fickett street; thence southerly a parallel with the easterly line of Fickett street to the point of beginning.

Excepting therefrom any land the in contained which is now a part of a public street or alley.

Sec. 3. The City Superintendent of Streets shall cause notice of the passage of this Ordinance to be posted on and about the corners of the street

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published for ten days in the Los Angeles Herald and thereupon and thereafter it shall take effect and be in force.

An Ordinance declaring the intent

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Council of the City of Los Angeles to establish the grade of TWENTY-EIGHTH STREET, from Nevil avenue to Long Beach avenue.

At the intersection with Morgan ave the grade shall be 201.50 at the southwest corner, and 202.00 at a point on the north side of the road, and 202.00 at the northeast corner, and 202.00 at the southeast corner.

And at all points between said designated points the grade shall be established so as to conform to a straight line drawn between said designated points.

Elevations refer to the top of the curb, are in feet and are above a plane which is 255 feet below City datum plane.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published for ten days in the Los Angeles Herald and thereupon and thereafter it shall take effect and be in force.

Ordinance No. 11,387

An Ordinance declaring the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles to establish the grade of Cambridge street, from Harvard boulevard to Hobart boulevard.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Council of the City of Los Angeles to establish the grade of Cambridge street, from Harvard boulevard to Hobart boulevard.

to establish
CAMBRIDGE STREET
from Harvard boulevard to Hobart bou-
levard in accordance with the follow-
ing elevations:

At the intersection with Harvard bou-
levard the grade shall be 200.84 at the
northwest corner and 200.96 at the south-
west corner.

At a point on the north side 150 feet
west of the west line of Harvard bou-
levard the grade shall be 200.84 at the
northwest corner and 200.96 at the south-
west corner.

At the intersection with Hobart boulevard the grade shall be 200.63 at the northeast corner, and 200.73 at the southeast corner, as now established on Hobart boulevard.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published for five days in the Los Angeles Herald-Examiner and thereupon and thereafter it shall

take effect and be in force.
