WHOLESALE DISMISSALS IN BUREAU NOT PLANNED

WASHINGTON, April 5.—Apprehensions which have beset the minds of the army of government employes in Washington since President Harding's overnight removal of 29 Bureau of Engraving officials were allayed partially today by Secretary Mellon, who circulated among the personnel of the treasury department a memorandum saying that reports of impending wholesale dismissals in the internal revenue bureau were without foundation.
