On and After the 2d of March

Messages in plain language will be accepted for transmission between the places mentioned below:
HONOLULU, OAHU, KA LAU, MOLOKAI, MAUNALEI, LANAI; and LAHAINA, MAUI.
The charge for such messages will be at the rate of 20 cents per word of 15 letters until further notice.
When telephone connections are available messages may be handed to the telephone company to be forwarded to destinations other than those mentioned above.
In other cases special messengers may be employed.
The cost of special delivery is not included in the charge at 20 cents per word. If the cost is known it must be paid by the sender when the message is handed in. If unknown, it must be paid by the addressee when the message is delivered.
