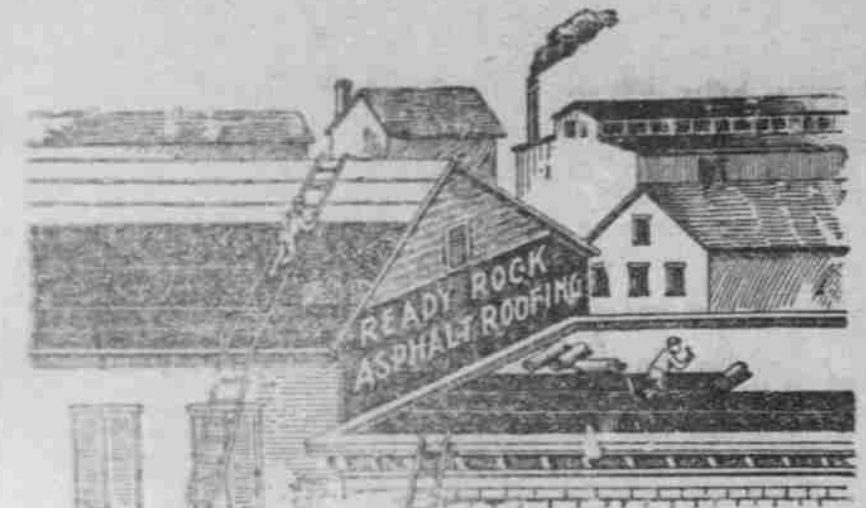

## McKINLEY RESOLUTIONS.

Action of Merchants' Association in re Death of President.

The following resolutions were passed by the Merchants' Association in regard to the death of President McKinley and were forwarded yesterday:

By the Merchants' Association of Honolulu, Territory of Hawaii:

Whereas, In the death of William McKinley, President of the United States, the world has lost one of its most efficient and conscientious rulers; this nation has lost one of its ablest and most enlightened members, whose life as citizen, soldier, statesman and President has been such as to make him a model worthy of all emulation; this Territory has lost a friend who has done much to promote the welfare and enhance the material prospects of all its residents; and his family has lost a protector whose loving care and guidance can never be replaced.

Be it therefore resolved, That in this trying time we do add to the general expression, that of our own heartfelt sorrow at the death of this great benefactor of mankind, the loss which has been sustained by the nation, and our appreciation of all that was done by him for the interests of this Territory; and that we do furthermore extend to Mrs. McKinley and the other members of his family in their great affliction our most sincere sympathy and condolence.

And be it further resolved, That these resolutions be spread upon the minutes of the Association and that copies be engrossed and forwarded to Mrs. McKinley and to Hon. A. E. Hitchcock, Secretary of the Interior.
