The World of Business. Wall Street Yesterday. New York, June 12.—The dealings in stocks this week averaged about 250,000 shares a day against a daily average of 150,000 shares a short time ago. The transactions in bonds have increased from less than \$1,000,000 par value a day to \$1,500,000 per day.

The strength of the market has been attributed largely to the progress that has been made toward perfecting the pending tariff measure. The belief that the new revenue bill would become a law soon after July 1 has also affected general business favorably, and that, in turn, has been reflected to an extent in the dealings on the stock exchange.
