day by the teachers' retirement commission, the first since the organization of this body as a result of an enactment of the last legislature, and the first, for that matter, in the history of the state. The two teachers who have spent nearly all of their lives in teaching the young of Salt Lake are Miss Anna E. Buchanan and Miss Mollie

Miss Buchanan was for many years one of the most valued of the teachers in the High school. She will receive a pension of \$30.74 per month for two years, and then it will be increased to \$39.30 for the rest of her life. Miss Templeton will receive a monthly pension of \$23,70 for two years, and it will then be increased to \$30.60 a month. Miss Buchanan has taught school for more than thirty years, eighteen of which were spent in the High school

The pension is based upon her earnings, as the retiring teachers receive an allowance of one-half of their regular earnings. Miss Buchanan earned \$21,-567.95 during her life as a teacher, or an average of \$943.18 annually. The law specifies that a teacher must pay into the fund 1 per cent of her earnings during the time of service, which would amount to \$215.68. This will be paid in two years by Miss Buchanan by deducting \$8.56 monthly from her pension, after which she will receive the full allowance of \$39.30 per month, or \$471.59

Miss Templeton had practically the same length of service, eighteen years of which were spent in the grade schools of Salt Lake, mostly at the Oquirrh, during which time she earned \$17,316.79. One per cent of this goes into the fund, and will be deducted from her allowance the same as that of Miss Buchanan. So, for two years, Miss Templeton will receive \$23.70, with the deduction of \$6.90 per month, and then her monthly pension will be \$30.60, where

Thirty years is specified by law as the time of service for full retirement pensions, one-third of which must be spent in the Salt Lake schools. Miss Buchanan is now in Los Angeles and Miss Templeton in St. Louis, both in poor health. Telegrams were sent to both that pensions were granted, and both will be most helpful to the teachers who gave so much of their life in educating the young of Salt Lake. Both teachers were in active service up to the closing of the schools for the sum-

mer vacation this year. These are the first pensions granted under the retirement commission law, and show the benefits derived from the organization. Most of the teachers of the city are in the organization, and 1 per cent of their earnings each month go into the general fund for the pensioning of the older teachers who have given the best years of their lives in the class rooms. Similar movements have been started in other parts of the United States. There is now about \$5,000 in the treasury of the commission, to be used only for this purpose,
