Convict's Story of Buried Millions Starts a Gold Rush in Missouri.

Eminence, Mo.-A hunt for supposed buried treasure has started on Jack's fork of Current river, near here, as a result of a story told by Howard D. Bolling, recently convictof the murder of Roy Sitton, city marshal of Winona, and sentenced to thirty years in the state penitentiary.
