Instructions have been sent out from the postmaster general in regard to the late order of the postoffice department concerning box rent, in which the pinches will greatly ease it. The moist following language is used: No box heat will cause the leather to give to can be used by any individual, family, firm, corporation or public official until rent thereon has been paid in advance for one quarter or the unexpired portion of a quarter. If box renters do use by them by the payment of rent by the 10th of January, April, July and October, you must close their boxes against them, place their mail in the general delivery and rent boxes formery used by them. No exception to this rule will be permitted." Box renters should comply with this order and save themselves annoyance and the postmaster embarrasament.
