

Bids For Much Work on Houston Channel Opened at Galveston

By The Associated Press. GALVESTON, Texas, March 11.—Bids to widen and deepen the Houston ship channel from Galveston bay to Morgan's Point, midway between Galveston and Houston, were opened here today at a meeting of experts of firms submitting bids with Colonel Simpson Cook, United States army engineer, in charge of river and harbor work in this district. Only four bids were received ranging from \$1.2 to \$1.4 cents per cubic yard for the different sections of the channel. They will be forwarded to Washington as soon as tabulated.
