The City Enters Suit Against the Southern Railway.

AN EFFORT TO RECUP

Raleigh, N. C., July 25.-The city of Raleigh has begun suit against the Southern Railway for \$3,222.27.

This is the amount of the damages and costs paid by the city for injuries sustained by a lady in a runaway at the railroad trestle on South street.

The city alleges that the railroad was responsible for the accident in that it had not constructed the trestle across the street in the manner prescribed by the city charter and the law of North Carolina.
