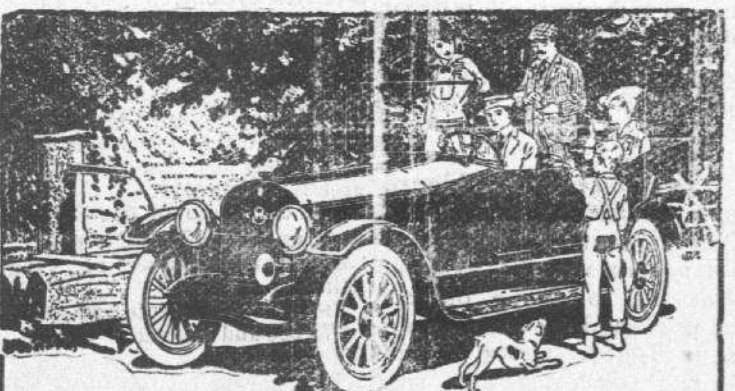

FEBRUARY 3rd, 1916

The Police Jury met this day in
regular monthly session, with the Hon.
A. Lasseigne in the chair and the fol-
lowing members present: Messrs. LeBrun
Bourgeois, Nagel, Barré, and Songy
Lasseigne.

Absent None.

The minutes of the last meeting were
read and approved.

The Finance Committee reported
favorably on numerous bills which were
ordered paid.

Moved by Mr. Le Brun, seconded by
Mr. Nagel, that the bill of Mr. John F.
Fitzgerald for \$77.65 dollars for relief
of the Frontier people after the storm of
Sept. 29 1915 be paid.

and that the President is hereby author-
ized to sell to the Parish of St. Charles
the half of the Boat purchased for that
cause by Mr. J. T. Fitzgerald. A vote
being called resulted as follows:

Yace: Nagel Songy, Barré Bourgeois
Lasseigne, and Le Brun.

Nays: None.

Moved by Mr. Nagel and seconded by
Mr. Barré that Mr. Lucien Desroche be
named Pound Keeper of the First ward.
Adopted.

There being no further business
on motion, duly recorded, the Jury
adjourned.
