### DRIFTED ON DERELICT.

#### Unusually Sailing Has a Narrowing Experience on High Sea.

Yates, B. C. Dev, 12—After drifting his days without food on a derelict, Thos. Anderson, a Swede, swam to shore on the west coast of Australia. He told a thrilling story of the disaster that had brought death to every member of the crew. News of the tragedy was brought here last night by the steamer Monna from Brisbane.

The derelict was a peering target of 200 tons, the High Norman. She was sailing down the coast from Brisbane to Fremantle when she struck a reef. The dingy was launched and all members of the crew except Anderson and the captain boarded her. The little boat drifted away and was swamped. All her occupants were drowned. Then Captain Arnold ordered Anderson to jump after the dingy, but seeing three sharks cruising in the vicinity, he refused.

Later the "sugar" drifted off the reef and the captain leaped overboard and tried to swim ashore, but he was attacked and devoured by sharks.

Next day Anderson decided to risk all in an effort to reach land. It took him one hour to swim ashore and he was rescued by sharks, but escaped them.
