## FOR LEPROSY

Dr. Rost Cultivates Bacillus of the Disease.

New York, July 13 .- Capt. E. R. Rost, of the Indian medical cervice, has succeeded in cultivating the bacillus of leprosy, acgoon, Burmah, says a Times special from London, He has made substance from the cultures which he calls leprolin, and which, when injected into lepers, has ing the symptoms of the disease. The method of growing the baccillus is to extract the salts from nutrient media, and Capt. Rost being sold for almost nothing. discovered that the baccillus will not grow in the presence of the salt. In order to make such nutrient media he instills beef extract soaked in pumice stone in a current of super-heated steam and obtains a medium in which the baccillus of leprosy, and also that of tuberculosis, grows with the greatest ease. Over 100 cases are being treated in Burmah, by injections of this substance and the treatment is also being tried in thirty places in India. Already four cases have been reported cured, and in the great majority of those under treatment the in


