#### GASOLINE EXPLOSION

Caused Fifty Thousand Dollar Blaze at Bronte, Texas.

Bronte, Coke Co., Texas, May 30.—Fire, caused by the explosion of gas accumulations from gasoline used in the tailor shop of Grimes & Frizzell, on Main street, consumed three frame business houses and one stone store building, with entire contents of each, at 1:30 this afternoon, causing an aggregate loss of about \$50,000, of which less than half was covered by insurance.
