Mr. Reeves has always ranked as one of the first lawyers of the state. He has, too, always taken an active interest in politics. In 1890 he was the nominee of the Democratic party for judge of the Fifth district and in 1894 he was nominated as a Populist for. attorney general on the fusion Democratic-Populist ticket. In 1897 he was elected mayor of Pocatello on a Citizens' ticket. leaves a wife and Mr
