### Financial Report of School Districts.

A law passed by the last legislature makes it the duty of the board of school trustees to furnish a report in writing on the first Monday in June of each year of the financial condition of their respective districts, showing the amount expended and in what manner and for what purposes expended, and the amount of money in the treasury of the district or to the credit of the district on hand at the date of the report, the said report to show fully the financial condition of the district at the date thereof.

Section two makes it the duty of the school trustees of each district to cause the said report to be published in a newspaper or posted in three conspicuous places in the district, and to retain a copy of the said report in the office of the clerk of the school board of said district where the same may be at all times open to examination and inspection by any person.

### Memorial Day Proclamation.

In pursuance of established custom, in memory of past sacrifices and in acknowledgment of exalted services unselfishly rendered, I, F. R. Gooding, Governor of Idaho, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, May 30, 1905, Memorial Day. I earnestly and sincerely recommend that the day be devoutly observed throughout the State by all the people in commemoration of the devotion and valor of our soldier dead, in whatever war they may have fought, and where-soever they may rest.

Lest we forget the principles of justice and liberty for which they fought let us each desist from our several occupations on that day. Let public and private offices be closed, and the day be

devoted to sacred memories and consecrated to holy purposes. Let the flag, beneath whose folds our soldier dead marched to our nation's battles, be seen at half-mast on every public building, and on the portals of every home. Let our sincerity of devotion prove a lesson to the children of the value of our free institutions, and of the beauty and sacredness of the land in which we live, and which they must soon have in their keeping.

Done at the Capitol in Boise, under my hand and the great seal of the State of Idaho, this 22nd day of May, 1905, and of the Independence of the United States the One Hundred and twenty-ninth.
