When we read of the damage done by high winds and floods in the widely advertised winter resorts of California and elsewhere, we can truthfully proclaim that "it is a pleasure to live in Bear Lake valley." It is true we are at present "housed up" to some extent by the heavy blanket of snow which covers the valley, but that is really a blessing for it means an ample supply of water for irrigation during the coming season.

While it would be folly to claim that Bear Lake valley is a Garden of Eden, yet take it year after, the seasons here will compare most favorably with those of many of the far famed sections of the world. Here we know nothing of blizzards, tornadoes, floods or extreme heat. Here people do not freeze in winter nor die from sun strokes in summer. Here crops are not ruined by hot winds, and floods cometh not to devastate homes. Verily, you can look far and wide and not find an abiding place that will average up with Bear Lake valley.

Representative Oversmith of Latah county, is out with a statement in which he favors a one house legislative plan of reducing the cost of government and securing fewer and better laws. Well, that sounds strange coming from the gentleman from Latah, who was about the most "pro-life cuss" in the house last winter. We know he did the most talking and is we are not mistaken, he introduced

more bills than any other one member of that body. He championed everything in the shape of "reform" legislation, which would have added to the cost of government had they been enacted into laws. We are glad to learn that he has had a change of heart on the question of law making, but we fear that if he were made a member of the one house legislature that prolific brain of his would get to working again on bills, and unless a check was put on him there would be no diminution in the number of laws enacted.

A goodly number of Bannock county republicans indulged in a real old fashioned love feast and experience meeting at Downey last Saturday afternoon and evening. A "get together" spirit prevailed at the meeting and the indications are that the republicans of old Bannock will present a practically united front in the coming campaign. There may be a few radical ones who will follow Broxon et al into the democratic aid society, otherwise known as the progressive party, but the number will not be sufficient to materially injure the republican party in that county.

The progressives declare they are for retrenchment and are yet loud for the recall, clear down the line even to judicial decisions, the initiative and referendum, and so forth. All of these if put into practice, means almost constant elections. Hence there could be no retrenchment under such a system. Public expense would increase by leaps and bounds. There can be no consistency between retrenchment and recall. One need not take anybody's declaration for it—they need only go to Oregon or Colorado for instance and be convinced.—Jerome News.

### IN MEMORIAM

To the officers and members of Enterprise Lodge, No. 18, I. O. O. F., Montpelier, Idaho:  
Whereas, It has pleased the Divine Father to take from our midst our beloved Brother Thomas J. Harrison, who was a member of our order for many years, being a charter member of Preston Lodge, No. 112 and transferred to Enterprise lodge in 1905 and remained in good standing until the time of his death, Nov. 30th, 1913. Brother Harrison was born in England about sixty three years ago and came to the United States when he was 18 years old. Here is what Mr. W. W. Riter, president of the Deseret Nation bank of Salt Lake City, Utah, has to say about him.

"I first met Thomas J. Harrison in London in 1884. His parents were of the Mormon faith. Thomas was at this time driving a hearse. He next turned up to my view at a grading camp on Bitter creek, during the construction of the Union Pacific road in 1888. He was woefully poor and for lack of shoes he wore gunny sacks wrapped around his feet, but he was undaunted and as happy as if he were a millionaire. We had no work for him then and used him for a rooster about. He soon gave evidence of an honest and sterling character, and we put him to work and he remained with us until the completion of the Union Pacific road. He was what would be called in the parlance of those days, a jolly cuss. I met him now and then in the subsequent years, and whilst very rough in his exterior, he had an unusually warm and generous heart. I believe he would tear his shirt out and give half or all of it, if necessary, to some less fortunate being. While lacking all the refinements of culture and education, I doubt if many men possessed a greater number of the elements of true manhood than our dear friend Tom. Peace to his ashes."

Such a fine tribute from so eminent a gentleman as Mr. Riter to the virtues of our deceased brother is positive proof that this order made no mistake when they admitted him as a member, and from our association with him during his connection with this lodge we can fully endorse the commendatory tribute of Mr. Riter and we can unite with him in saying "Peace to his ashes."

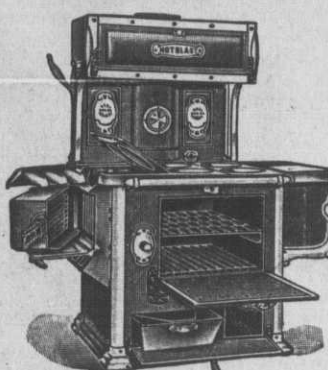
