res Tariff is Wicked Tax inefit Beet Sugar Interests of the Country.

WILL MAKE WAR FOR REPEAL OF TARIFF

ares Uncle Sam Takes Third of Price of Each Pound of Sugar at Present.

NEW YORK, Oct. 12—Before sailing for Europe today John Arbuckic desued a statement strongly attack ing the tarfit on raw sugar, dealaring it to be a "wicked tax" for the senent of the sugar interests. In his statement Mr. Arbuckic said:

"I am going abroad to rest and recuperation for the fight to be made in congress at its next session for free sugar. I propose to devote all my time and all my shifty and all my strength to the abolity of all our people. It taxes the man who works for a wage of a dollar a day as much as it taxes an Astor or Mr. Rocke feller. Each eats, or at least needs, who are the same amount of sugar, and they pay not according to their needs, reversing an elemental rule of taxation.
