The alarm of treasury officials over the discovery of \$100 counterfeit silver certificates has been increased by later developments.

One of these counterfeits appeared in a package of bills received from the Chicago subtreasury, another was found in the St. Louis branch and a third in the Philadelphia remittance. Another was brought to light in the cash of the National Bank of Washington,

Department officials believe have been in circulation for several weeks.

Mr. Cramer, assorting clerk of the Philadelphia subtreasmry, who first brought the counterfeits to the attention of the department, said that he saw a Louis bas \$1,750,000.
