

## POSTAL MEN GET WAGE INCREASE

Congress Finally Agrees to  
Raise Pay of Employees in  
Post Office Service.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 31.—South  
Bend postal employees will be inter-  
ested in the final agreement of con-  
gress increasing the pay of employees  
in the postal service. This legisla-  
tion finally agreed to provides:

### Rate of Pay.

Postmasters at offices of the third  
class; assistant postmasters and  
clerks, including clerks at division  
headquarters of postoffice inspec-  
tors; special clerks, finance clerks,  
bookkeepers, printers, mechanics,  
skilled laborers, watchmen, messen-  
gers, laborers and other employees of  
offices of the first and second class;  
letter carriers in the city delivery  
service; employees in government-  
owned automobile service; super-  
visory officials, inspectors, railway  
postal clerks, including substitutes;  
superintendents, requisition filers,  
packers and laborers; the agent in  
charge, clerks and messengers at  
the United States stamped envelope  
agency, Dayton, O., and employees of  
the mail equipment shop who re-  
ceive compensation at the rate per  
annum of:

Not less than \$1,000 nor more  
than \$1,200, to be increased \$200.  
More than \$1,200 and not more  
than \$1,600, to be increased \$150.  
More than \$1,600 and not more  
than \$2,000, to be increased \$125.  
More than \$2,000 and not more  
than \$2,500.00 to be increased  
\$100.

No third class postmaster shall  
receive more than \$2,000 per an-  
num.

### Village Carrier Pay.

Carriers in the village delivery  
service and other employees paid  
from lump-sum appropriations, re-  
ceiving compensation at the rate of  
less than \$1,000 per annum, to be  
increased 20 per cent of their pre-  
sent compensation.

Rural letter carriers on daily  
routes and rural letter carriers on  
two tri-weekly routes whose routes  
are:

Eleven miles or less in length, to  
be increased \$75.

Over eleven miles and under 20  
miles in length, to be increased \$100.

Twenty miles and under twenty-

four miles in length, to be increased

\$150.

Twenty-four miles or over in

length, to be increased \$200.

Rural letter carriers on tri-weekly

routes of:

Eleven miles or less in length, to

be increased \$27.50.

Over eleven miles and under 20

miles in length, to be increased \$50.

Twenty miles and under twenty-

four miles in length, to be increased

\$75.

Twenty-four miles or over in

length, to be increased \$100.

Postmasters at offices of the fourth

class to be increased by an amount

equal to 15 per cent of their pre-

compensation.

Substitute, temporary and auxil-

iary clerks at first and second

class postoffices and substitutes,

temporary and auxiliary letter car-

riers in the city delivery service, a

compensation of 50 cents per hour

for each hour of service performed.
