

## Counter Revolutionaries Victorious In Hungary

VIENNA, Oct. 5.—The social democratic party of Austria, numerically the largest in the Austrian parliament, charged in an appeal its leaders have issued asking for votes in the election for the national assembly on Oct. 17 that the counter-revolutionaries have been victorious in Hungary and that their "lynchings and guillotine are preparing the way for restoration in that country of the rule of the Hapsburgs." This is the line of which the late Emperor Francis Joseph and his son Carl were descendants.

"Carl Hapsburg has broken his word and refused to resign the Austrian throne," the socialists aver. "He is to be made King of Hungary in Budapest and from there he is to bring German Austria into subjection. The blood of our peasants and our workers is again to be placed in the service of the Hungarian feudal lords who are arming for war to reconquer Slovakia, Steiermark and the Banat." The socialists then charge that the Kunschak-Funder group of the Christian socialist party in Austria is the tool of the Hungarian monarchists.

This appeal and other campaign literature, not only of the socialist groups but the conservatives as well, cleverly continues the agitation for union with Germany. "From the day of our breakdown," it says, "we social democrats have said German Austria alone can be a living state. Economic misery will be our

lot so long as union with Germany does not free us."

It blames France for preventing this end but declares that the history of the Czechs, the Poles and Jugos-Slavs proves that a people finally achieves its own right of self-determination in spite of all opposition and all obstacles if only it remains firm in its desire.

The social democrats put forward as their issues the reforms they have advocated since the formation of the republic and which they assert have been defeated by the combined bourgeois opposition. In the main these are suppression of the power of the clerics, taxation of capital and of estates, age and invalid insurance, school reforms including separation of schools and church, adequate pay for public servants, and similar measures.

To this end it demands the socialization of great industries, mines, vast realty holdings and banking so that "their earnings, instead of enriching private persons may give to the state means of fulfilling its social and cultural tasks."

The Christian socialists are charged with obstructing this program so long that the control of many of the most valuable natural sources of wealth such as the iron mines of Styria and Carinthia have passed to Italian control and now foreign protests make impossible the full realization of the socialization scheme.

## ELKHART PRICES IN LUMBER GAME SLIDE DOWNWARD

Note 35 Percent Decrease  
in Builders' Supplies.

ELKHART, Ind., Oct. 5.—The decline in prices, as reflected in the local lumber and building supply business, amounts to a decrease of about 35 per cent on wholesale prices, according to the estimates of local dealers. Retail prices have not yet been affected, in the opinion of the Elkhartians, who add that the wholesale reductions are not sudden but have been spread over the past five months.

No. 1 common plain sawed oak, one-inch, which sold at the peak for \$150 a thousand feet, now is procurable for \$90, said H. I. Isbell of the Isbell Lumber & Coal Co., and R. W. Monger, of the Monger Lumber Co. Yellow pine flooring has dropped 40 per cent, the same men said.

Dealers have not yet bought much lumber at the reduced prices. It was said, and hence the consumer will not receive the benefit of the reductions for some time to come.

Additional building plans commenced here during the past included breaking of ground for the

new Wolf Avenue Evangelical church at the corner of Oakland Ave. and Leonard Ave. It is expected the foundation will be completed this fall, and the remainder of the building will be put up in the spring. The structure will be in Grecian style, three stories high, with a large auditorium and gallery. There will be 12 separate class rooms, and the entire building will be modeled along the most modern lines of church construction.

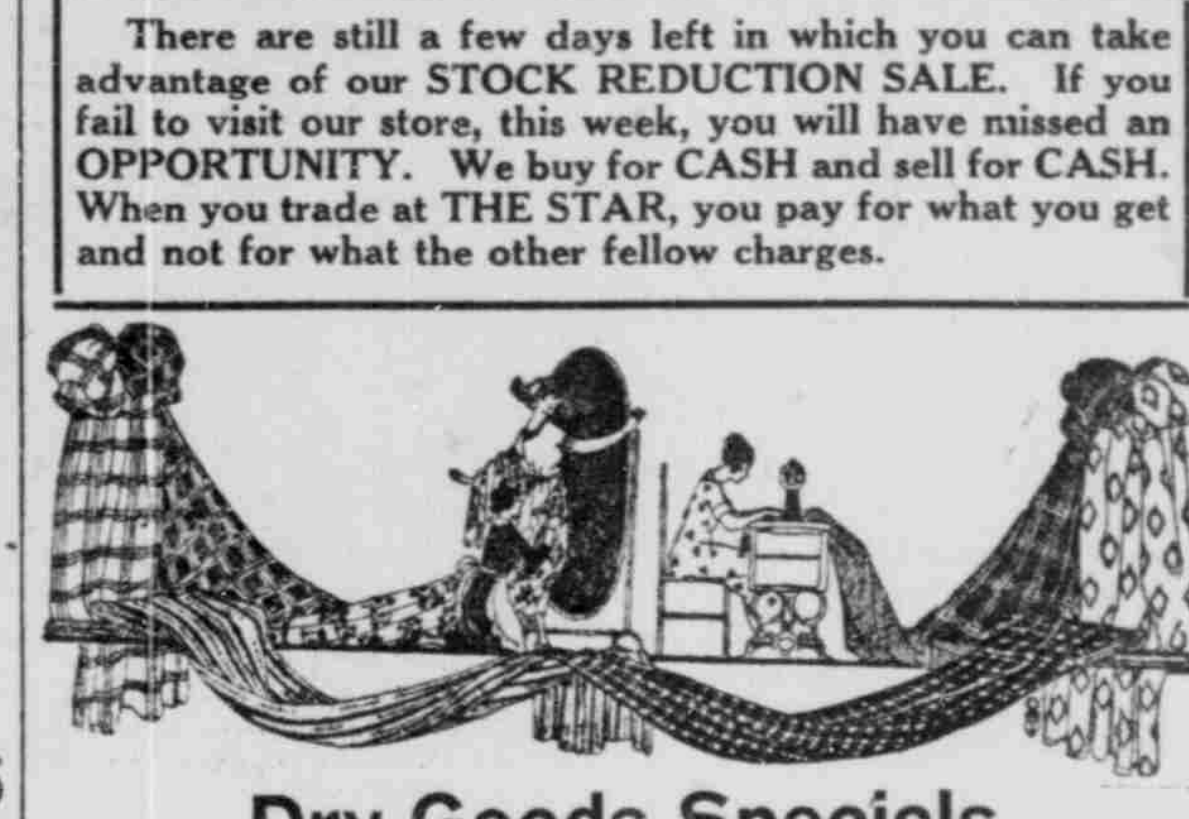

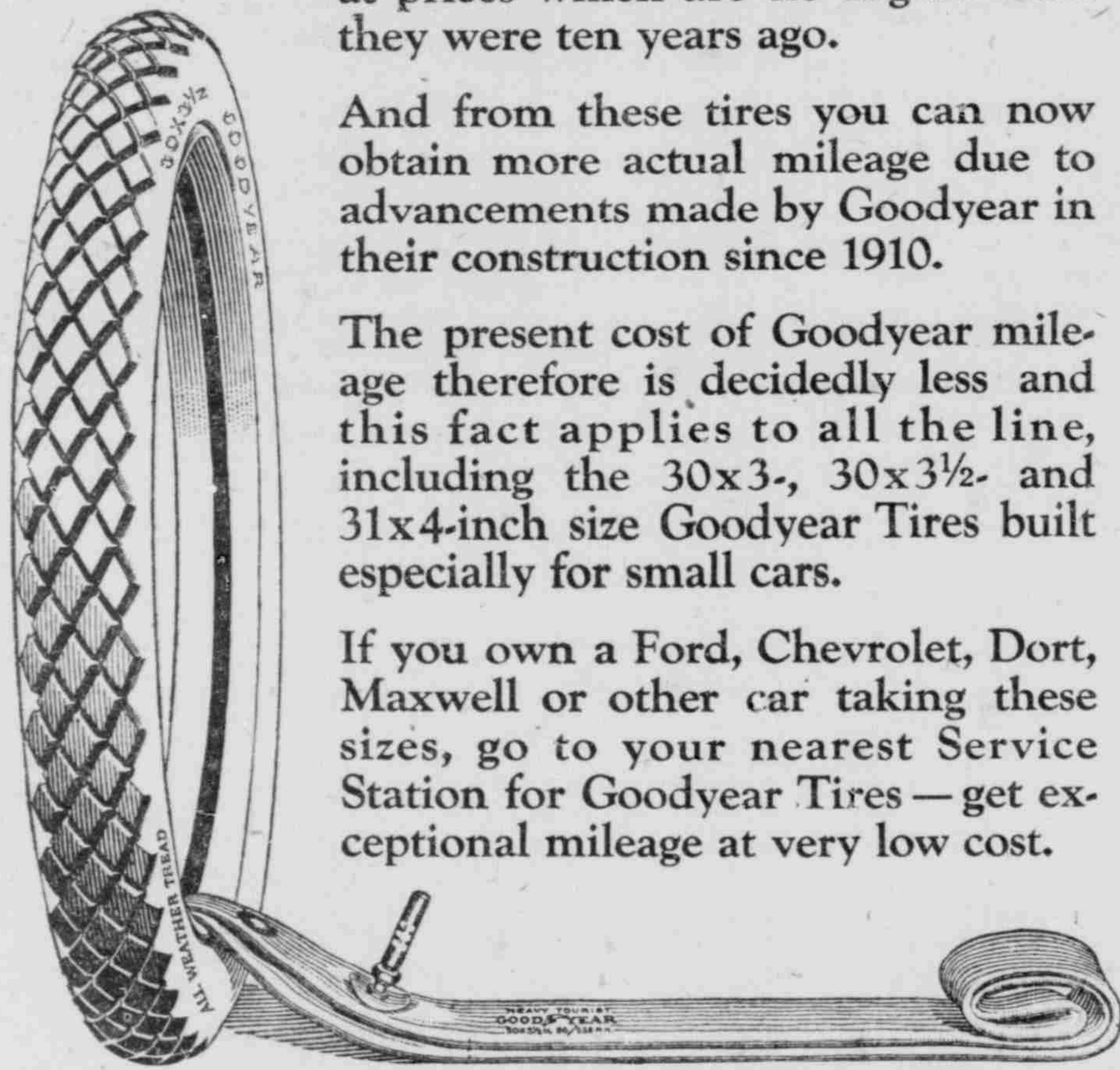
