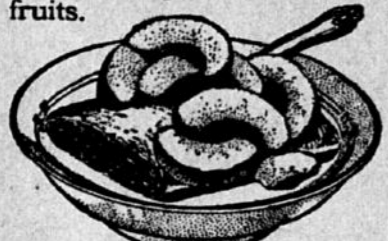

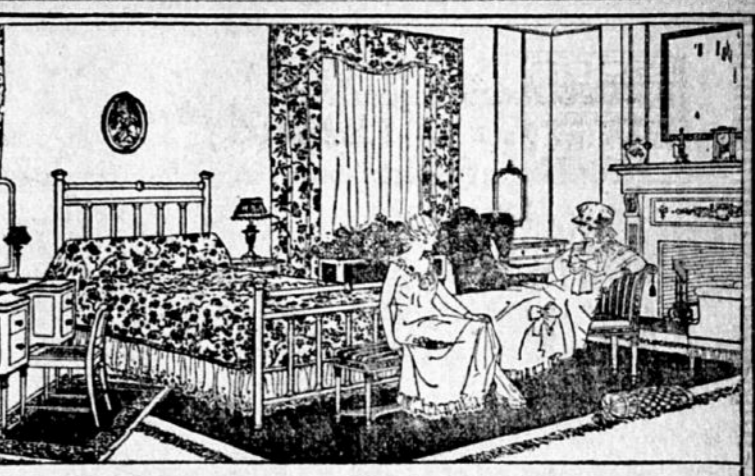
DEATH OF MRS. E. J. PETERSON
