# TUCSON LADY IS HEIR TO MILLIONS

CLAIMS TO BE A DAUGHTER OF JOHN D. WALKER, WHO DIED IN 'FRISCO—ONLY ARIZONA MILLIONAIRE IN THE FIFTIES.

For hte past five years, says the Tucson Citizen, within a stone's throw of Stone avenue, a woman by the name of Jade Walker has been living in abject poverty, all this time realizing, as she claims, that she is the only living heir of a man who, upon his death bed, willed her a half million in an estate valued at almost a million dollars.

John D. Walker, the only millionaire in Arizona in the early fifties, is alleged to have been the woman's father, and when he died, thirteen years ago, in his home in San Francisco, a conservative estimate placed the value of his estate at about \$800,000.

Jade Walker, the woman living in Tucson, is a half-breed Cherokee Indian, her mother, Walker's wife, being a full-blooded member of this tribe. John D. Walker was the owner of the Vekol silver mine, located thirty-eight miles southwest of Casa Grande, in Pinal county, which was sold just a few days ago for \$250,000 to a party of Alabama capitalists. Hearing of the sale of this mine, Miss Walker at once decided to take steps to secure her share of the money, and beyond doubt, within the next few weeks, a suit will be filed in the district court at Tucson to restrain the Dragg brothers of Phoenix, who hold a mortgage upon the stock of the mine, from transferring the property to the southern men.

The Imperial Copper company's coming big smelter town, under the direct auspices of the Southern Arizona Smelting company, a subsidiary corporation, is getting well in evidence in several directions, says the Tucson Star. It is now reported that their 500-ton smelter at Sasco will be blown in as a New Year's present to the stockholders of both organizations. Sasco promises to be a big town, and the 110 acres platted by capitalists both in Tucson and the Imperial mine, and lying just south of the smelter company's domain, is attracting considerable attention from let buyers. There are 400 lots open to sale with prices ranging from \$100 to \$400 per lot. Lots are 50x150 and Trustee Dunan reports fifty lots sold within the past week.
